iConquerMS Spotlight – ACTRIMS Forum 2018

The ACTRIMS Forum 2018 took place February 1-3 in San Diego, at which some of the leading minds in MS research discussed exciting new findings. Dr. Robert McBurney presented data at this meeting summarizing and comparing the [characteristics of participants in the iConquerMS network](#) with relapsing remitting and those with progressive forms of MS.

These data revealed interesting differences in the ranking of symptoms, functioning and quality of life across the different forms of MS. For instance, lower extremity functional disability was more common in people with progressive MS and fatigue was a common symptom across the board. This summary of the iConquerMS network highlights areas of quality of life that affect people with relapsing and progressive forms of MS and provides an excellent resource for future research.
