Our Engagement Process

Engaging with Accelerated Cure Project for MS (ACP) is a simple, four-step unified process, whether you need access to our biosample and data repository, our iConquerMS people-powered research network, or our inclusive engagement resources.

1. INITIAL CONVERSATION

Email our partnerships team with a brief outline of your research needs. We'll schedule an introductory call to learn more about your goals.

2. PROJECT SCOPING & PROPOSAL

During our call, we will discuss your specific needs in detail. Based on this conversation, we will jointly develop a project proposal that includes options for collaboration, a timeline, and a cost estimate.

3. COMMITTEE REVIEW & AGREEMENT

To ensure all projects are people-centric and scientifically valuable, your proposal will be reviewed by the relevant ACP research committee. Once approved, we will execute the necessary agreements, such as a service agreement, material transfer agreement (MTA), or data transfer agreement (DTA).

4. PROJECT LAUNCH

With the agreements in place, we will get started. Our team will work with you to deliver the data, samples, or community insights your project requires.
